The Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED) announced the opening of a grant program that provide entrepreneurs and small business with technical assistance services. See note below from DEED with information on how to apply and a FAQ page:

The Department of Employment and Economic Development is [releasing applications for the Small Business Partnership Grant Program](#). We are seeking proposals from non-profits and public entities to provide and facilitate business development assistance and technical assistance services to entrepreneurs and small businesses. Applications open today and are due by **4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 15th.**

The purpose of this grant is to support the start-up, growth, and success of Minnesota’s entrepreneurs and small business owners through the delivery of high quality free or low-cost professional business development and technical assistance services. The successful implementation of these grant funded projects will help facilitate an economic environment that produces job growth and supports the economic success of Minnesota individuals, businesses, and communities by providing opportunities for growth.

Funding will be allocated through a competitive process with a review by a committee of DEED staff and managers and external reviewers. Award decisions will be final and not subject to appeal. If selected, you may only incur eligible expenses when the grant contract agreement is fully executed by the awardee and DEED and the grant has reached its start date, October 2021.

BACK-TO-SCHOOL TAX BREAKS

I wanted to make sure parents know about tax incentives that may allow them to keep more of their hard-earned money come tax season. Minnesota has both a credit and a subtraction for education expenses.

Most school supplies qualify for the credit or subtraction, including writing utensils, textbooks, and musical instrument rentals.

To qualify for either program, you must:

- Have a qualifying child attending kindergarten through 12th grade at a public, private, or qualified home school. For details, go to [Qualifying Child for K-12 Education Subtraction and Credit](#).
- Have paid “qualified education expenses” during the year for that child’s education. For details, go to [Qualifying Expenses for the K-12 Education Subtraction and Credit](#).

PREPARING FOR ANOTHER COVID-19 WAVE

“An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure” – Reported by Mayo Clinic Health System – Sept 2, 2021

Our modeling shows that within the next month, our ICU and hospital beds will likely fill with COVID-19 patients, straining our ability to care for them and still leave room for other patients who need procedures and emergency hospitalization for conditions like heart attacks or strokes. The most tragic part of the situation is that most of these hospitalizations and nearly all the deaths are preventable if eligible people get vaccinated for COVID-19. Recent data show unvaccinated people account for 99.5% of U.S. hospital deaths due to COVID-19. Of more concern, recent experience in states where the surge is peaking highlights that children and young adults make up a much higher number of seriously ill patients infected by this virus. If you have been putting off getting vaccinated for COVID-19, now is the time to act. We are certain that vaccination for COVID-19, masking, social distancing and other measures we have taken inside our medical facilities make it possible to continue to provide safe medical care. These actions taken in the community, will help ensure that businesses can stay open, schools can conduct in-person learning safely and normal life can resume. [Here’s how you can do your part:](#)

- **Masking:** No matter your vaccination status, wear a mask when indoors and away from home. COVID-19 transmission rates are high across our entire area.
- **Social Distancing:** Practice social distancing whenever possible.
- **Vaccination:** Unless advised otherwise by your health care provider, [get vaccinated](#) for COVID-19 as soon as possible. Also, vaccinate your eligible children before they return to school.
- **Testing & Self-Isolating:** If you are not vaccinated for COVID-19 and are exposed to the virus, isolate immediately and get tested. No matter your vaccination status, if you have symptoms, it is critical to isolate and get tested.
- When you need care for a non-COVID illness or injury that is not an emergency, take advantage of one of the many options to get care you need – primary care provider, Same Day Clinic, Express Care (in person or online with a video visit), using the online Check Symptoms assessment tool in Patient Online Services or calling the Nurse Line.
- If you are called by our team after an exposure and are offered therapies such as the antiviral drug remdesivir or monoclonal antibody infusions, please strongly consider these treatments.
